Fire doors are essential in preventing the spread of fire and smoke between separate parts of a building by temporarily containing the fire while provide clear escape routes to those needing to exit the building.

They are specifically built and designed with approved fire-resistance ratings and are used as part of a building's fire protection system.

All communal doors and entrance doors to your flat are fire doors.

Please adhere to the below safety tips and do not put yourself or anyone else in danger.



Keep fire doors closed at all times, and make sure your fire doors close automatically. Please report any issues to ccha immediately.



Do not prop or wedge fire doors open for any reason.



Do not make any holes or openings to any fire doors. If there is damage, please report it to **ccha**.



If you are a homeowner, please seek **ccha**'s permission before changing your front door.



Please keep access to fire doors clear and free from obstruction.
